A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SADDLE CREEK COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT CHANGING ITS NAME FROM THE SADDLE CREEK COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT (SCCSD) TO THE COPPER VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT (CVCSD)

WHEREAS, Saddle Creek Community Services District was formed in 1995 by LAFCo Resolution 95-03 and pursuant to §56000 and 61000 et seq. of the California Government Code.

WHEREAS, The Saddle Creek Community Services District (SCCSD) provides road maintenance, storm drain maintenance, street lighting, landscaping of public areas, weed control and trail/fire break maintenance, mosquito abatement, and access gate control.

WHEREAS, It is the desire of the Board of Directors of the Saddle Creek Community Services District to Change the name of the district to the Copper Valley Community Services District.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, as follows:

- The name of the Saddle Creek Community Services District is hereby changed to the Copper Valley Community Services District effective upon passage of this resolution.
- The General Manager is hereby authorized to sign any and all documents on behalf of the Copper Valley Community Services District including all financial and other documents for Calaveras County, is authorized to handle all affairs of the Copper Valley Community Services District, and to act on behalf of the Copper Valley Community Services District.
- The Copper Valley Community Services District is the successor agency to the Saddle Creek Community Services District having identical powers and authorities as previously authorized.
